



Amifan

This is a pattern I made with sock yarn and crochet hook 1,25 mm.

It is tiny and cute. Sock yarn is more elastic and a bit more difficult to crochet with. So take your time to crochet this, but than it will be superb!

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Pattern

Mini the Bee



Used materials

- Crochet hook 1,25 mm
- Fiberfill
- Sewing needle
- Stich markers
- Safety eyes

Used colors



Crochet Terms (US)

ch = chain

sc = stich

slst = slip stich

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

inc = increase

dec = decrease

* * crochet .. x= repeat and crochet x times what is between * *

Pattern – mini Bee

Make this amigurumi with the same yarn as I did and it will be super tiny. Bigger yarn or hook makes them bigger.

Eye patches (2x)

Crochet with white yarn

Row 1. Crochet chain 3 and 1 chain to turn [4]

Row 2. Crochet in the second chain from the hook, 2sc, inc5 (in the last chain), turn to the other side off the chain, 1sc, inc, [10]

Row 3. ch1, 3sc, *inc* crochet 3x, 3sc, inc [13]

Safety eyes through the little hole on Row 2, in the inc5

Head

Black yarn

Rnd 1. 6sc in mr [6]

Rnd 2. *inc* crochet 6x [12]

Rnd 3. *inc, 1sc* crochet 6x [18]

Rnd 4. *1sc, inc, 1sc* crochet 6x [24]

Rnd 5. 1sc in every stich [24]

Rnd 6. *inc, 3sc* crochet 6x [30]

Rnd 7. *2sc, inc, 2sc* crochet 6x [30]



- Rnd 8. 1sc in every stich [36]
 Rnd 9. 1sc in every stich [36]
 Rnd 10. 1sc in every stich [36]
 Rnd 11. 1sc in every stich [36]
 Rnd 12. 1sc in every stich [36]
 Rnd 13. *2sc, 2scs, 2sc* crochet 6x [30]
 Rnd 14. *3sc, 2scs* crochet 6x [24]
 Rnd 15. 1sc in every stich [24]
 Rnd 16. *1sc, 2scs, 1sc* crochet 6x [18]
 Fill up the head. Place the eyes and eye patches on rnd 10. 4 sc in between them.
 Rnd 17. *2scs, 1sc* crochet 6x [12]
 Rnd 18. *2scs* crochet 6x [6]
 Fasten off.

Body

Start with white yarn, than black and yellow

- Rnd 1. 6sc in mr [6]
 Rnd 2. *inc, 1sc* crochet 3x [9]
 Rnd 3. *1sc, inc, 1sc* crochet 3x [12]
 Rnd 4. Change color black. 1sc in every stich [12]
 Rnd 5. *1sc, inc* crochet 6x [18]
 Rnd 6. Change color yellow. 1sc in every stich [18]
 Rnd 7. Change color black. 1sc in every stich [18]

- Rnd 8. Change color yellow. 1sc in every stich [18]
 Rnd 9. 1sc in every stich [18]
 Rnd 10. Change color black. *2scs, 1sc* crochet 6x [12]
 Rnd 11. 1sc in every stich [12]
 Fill up the body
 Rnd 12. Change color yellow. 1sc in every stich [12]

Antennas (2x)

Black yarn

Option 1: pull the yarn through rnd 4-5, at the front off the head (6 stiches apart), chain 6, turn, 1slst in 3e stich. Pull the rest off the yarn through the head and the antenna is on his place.

Option 2: chain 6, and 1 slst in 3^e chain. Leave a yarn for sewing. Sew on Rnd 4-5, 6 stiches apart (photo 1)

Wings (2x)

White yarn

- Row 1 Chain 20 and make a circle with a slst. [20]
 Row 2 30 sc around the chain (not in the stiches!) [30]

Fasten off and leave a long yarn. Use a sewing needle and go with the yarn from the one side to the other side.



Repeat this also 2x on the side (see photo 2) It must be a grid with 6 holes

Assembly

Sew with yellow yarn a little nose between the eyepatches. Two little stripes, 1 sc width.

Sew on the eyepatches with little stiches.

Sew the head on the body and the wings at the back.



CROCHET TIPS !

The amigurumi figures are crocheted in on going spiral. If crocheted in rows I will mention it in the pattern.

The colors yarn I used are just a hint. You always can use other colors. That is why I stopped telling which brand yarn I use. Except when I want to have a special effect.

I always use 100% cotton yarn or acryl when it must be fluffy.
